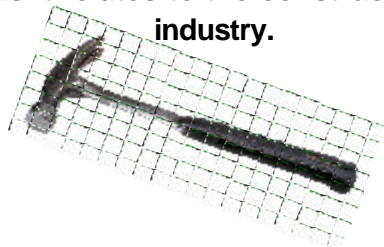

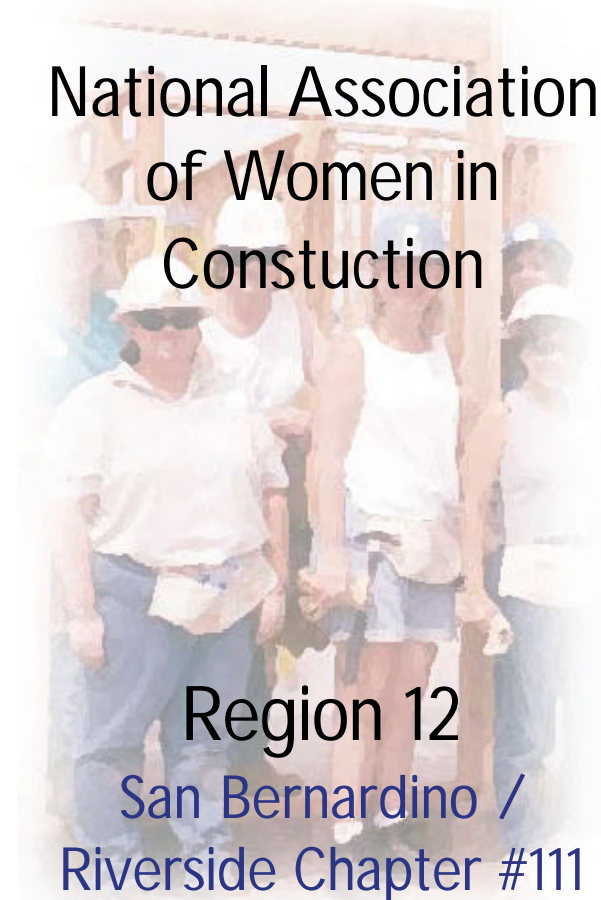

Since this time, **NAWIC** has grown to a membership of more than 4,500 with hundreds of chapters throughout the United States and Canada.

Networking

NAWIC promotes networking through quarterly regional meetings. Attendance at these meetings can be very beneficial to your business.
