SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS/GUIDELINES

• The NAWIC San Bernardino/Riverside Chapter No. 111 will annually seek scholarship candidates who possess a commitment to obtain an education leading to a degree through a course of study in construction or a technical skill related to construction.

• All applicants must have a 2.6 (C+) grade point average.

• The scholarship grant shall be applied toward the cost of tuition and/or course expenses as selected by the recipient(s), said amount no to exceed scholarship grant.

• The NAWIC San Bernardino/Riverside Chapter No. 111 Scholarship Committee will review all applicants. Appointments for personal interviews may be arranged. Completed applications, current official academic transcripts (internet transcripts not acceptable) and scholarships resumes must be received by the Scholarship Committee no later than March 31st of each year. Applications received after March 31st will not be considered. The Scholarship Committee will select a recipient(s) and present the recipient(s) to the Scholarship Advisory Committee at the April Board meeting. Following the Committee's approval, all applicants will be notified of the committee's decision.

• Scholarships are not automatically renewed, but each recipient will be considered for subsequent awards if he/she provides evidence of continued need, continued interest in construction, continued enrollment, and good standing in a construction related program leading to a degree or certificate. Prior scholarship recipient(s) must reapply annually for consideration.

• Scholarship recipient(s) are requested to maintain frequent contact with the NAWIC San Bernardino/Riverside Chapter No. 111 and when possible attend chapter functions.

• The recipient(s) will be invited to the NAWIC San Bernardino/Riverside Chapter No. 111 Construction Industry dinner at which time the scholarship recipients will be introduced.

• In order to maintain 501(c)(6) tax exempt status, scholarships may not be awarded to NAWIC members or their families.

• The National Association of Women in Construction is an equal opportunity organization.
